We may receive additional information from third parties such as analytics or advertising partners. This data helps us improve our services, better understand user behavior, and deliver relevant communications. Information collected is used to operate and improve our website, respond to inquiries, personalize experiences, and meet legal or regulatory requirements.

CentRE may share data with trusted service providers and business partners who assist with operations such as hosting, analytics, email delivery, or marketing. We may also share data as required by law or during a business transfer, merger, or acquisition. Certain data may be shared with third parties for business or marketing purposes in compliance with applicable privacy laws. You can opt out of some types of data sharing or targeted advertising by contacting us.

We retain personal information only as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this policy or as required by law. Reasonable security measures are in place to safeguard your information, though no system is entirely immune from unauthorized access or misuse.
